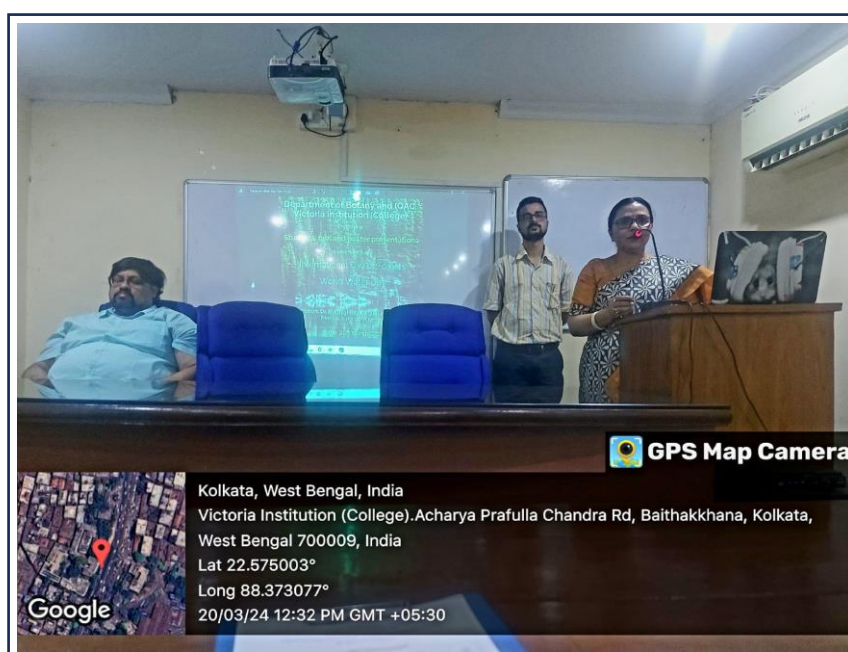


Observance of International Day of Forests (21st March) and World Water Day (22nd March) by Department of Botany, VIC

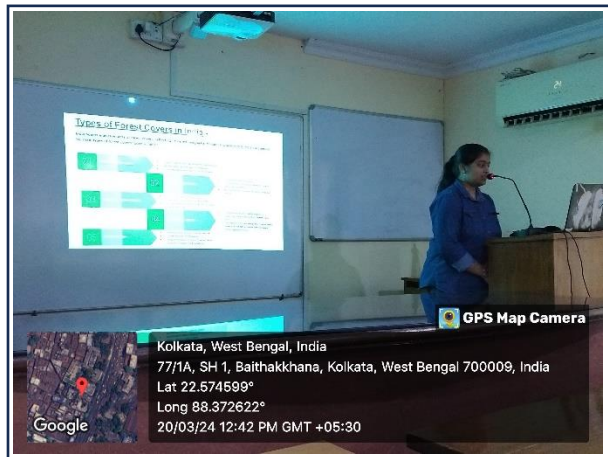

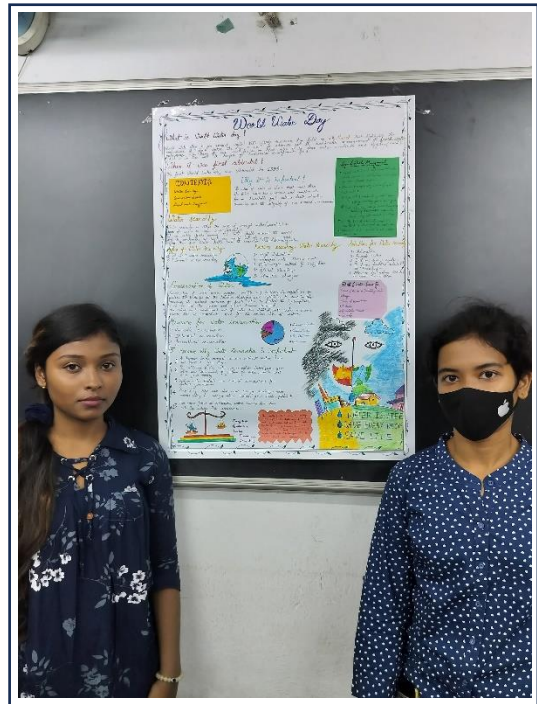
Overall, the event was a great success.
