- A campus interview was conducted by Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) in the college premises on February 2018 which generated a huge response especially among the students of outgoing batch. 17 students were selected by TCS.



- TCS conducted National Qualifier Test vide online mode on February 9, 2020. Students of B.A., B.SC and B.COM streams appeared for the test. The result was declared on February 19, 2020 and some students cracked the test. In the month of December 2020, TCS conducted an online interview with all the successful candidates over a phase of 15 days. 4 were selected.
- A Career Awareness Program was held by Eastern India Regional Council of The Institute of Cost Accountants of India on March 4, 2020 from 8 pm at the Keshub Memorial Hall of the College. The program was intended to enlighten the students of Commerce discipline about Cost and Management Accounting (CMA) Course and to encourage them in opting for CMA as their Profession.

- On September 6, 2020, IMS Learning Resources, Kolkata delivered a lecture for the students of Victoria Institution (College), which was organised by the Career Counselling Cell of the college. The topic was ‘Career Options and Job Market after Graduation in Post Pandemic Time’. The interactive session was very informative and helpful for the participants.
- In 2022, an off-campus recruitment drive was conducted by Infosys Limited to hire B.Com, BSc from 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 batch for Operations Executive role. It was conducted online in a phased manner comprising of Infosys online test and virtual interview. Candidates, who clear Infosys online test, progressed to the interview round and 2 were selected.



Career Counselling Cell has been established in our college with a focus on introducing job opportunities for our students. Our cell has been playing quite an active role in promoting job-orientated facilities for our students and make them aware about the importance of economic independence of women. (22.02.2023 to 04.03.2023)**

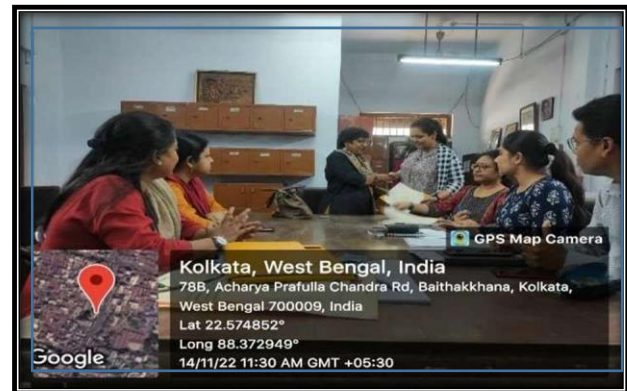
The Counselling Cell recently organised Add-on-Courses on Communicative English and Soft Skills, Life Skills and Digital Literacy. It was held on 22.02.2023 to 04.03.2023 (9 days' course for 36 hours). This highly demanding course was conducted by Naandi Foundation (NGO) in collaboration with the Mahindra Group. 221 students from all departments and streams joined in Soft Skill class and 107 students in Communicative English class. Six efficient trainers conducted the two courses parallelly in different rooms of our college.

Both the courses had huge positive response from the students, as they have been truly beneficial for their future prospects. After assessments, ranking students were provided with medals and trophies. All participants were provided with certificates.



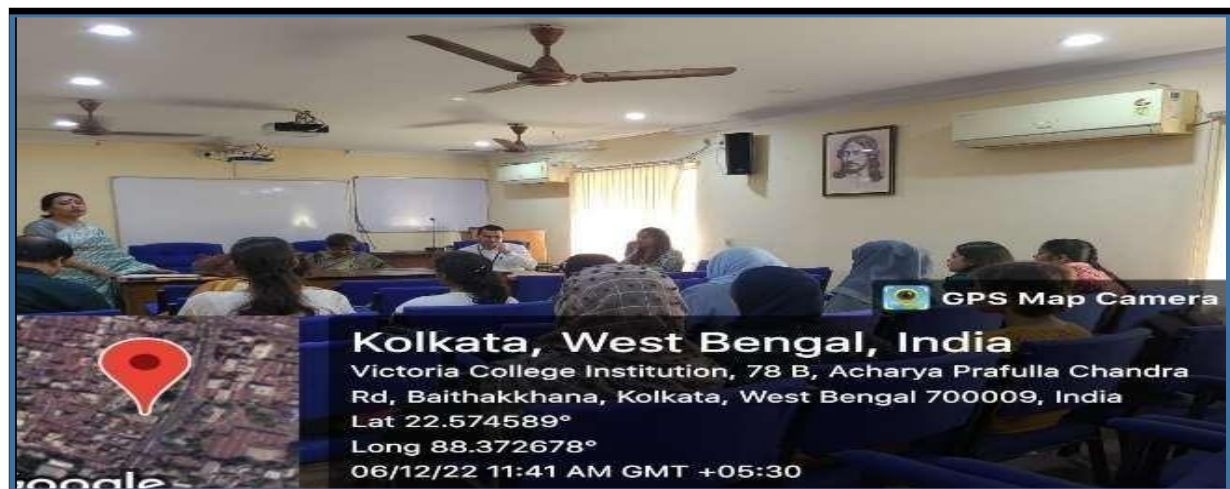
## Employability Skills Training Programme: 16<sup>th</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2022

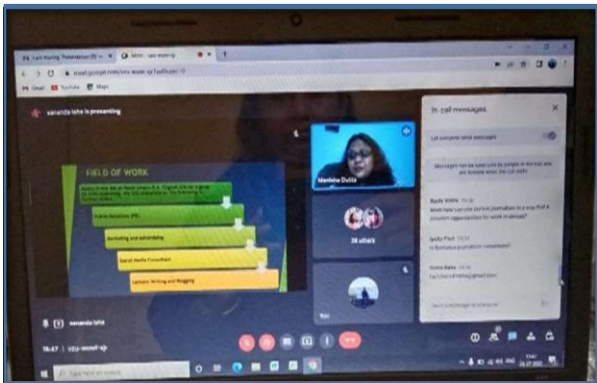
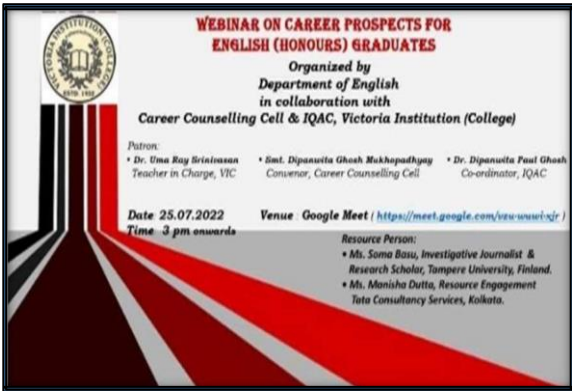
## Follow-Up Programme of Mahindra Pride Classroom: 6<sup>th</sup> December, 2022
