

Awareness and Sensitisation through Observance of anti-Ragging Day

Anti-ragging day was observed in the institution on 12.8.24 in two sessions in order to accommodate the students of Semester 1 from both Morning and Day sections. The first session was from 11.00 to 11.45 am while the second session took place from 12.00 to 12.45 pm.

The programme consisted of two items. At first was a Power Point Presentation which highlighted the common practices constituting ragging, our objectives to erase ragging and the effects of verbal and physical ragging.

The second item was a Short Play titled “We Shall Overcome”/ “আমরা করবো জয়” on Ragging enacted by the senior students from semesters 4 and 6. The play was written by Smt. Dipannita Ghosh Mukherjee, retired Associate Professor, Department of Economics of the college and directed by Dr Sukriti Lahori Sinha, Associate Professor, Department of Bengali. The play portrayed verbal and physical harassment and ragging in an institution, but ended with a positive note where the junior students united together to defeat this menace and finally all singing the title song which promised “we shall overcome”.
