

A report on online celebration of “International Day of Women and Girls in Science” organized by Dept. of Physics in collaboration with IQAC on 11th February 2024

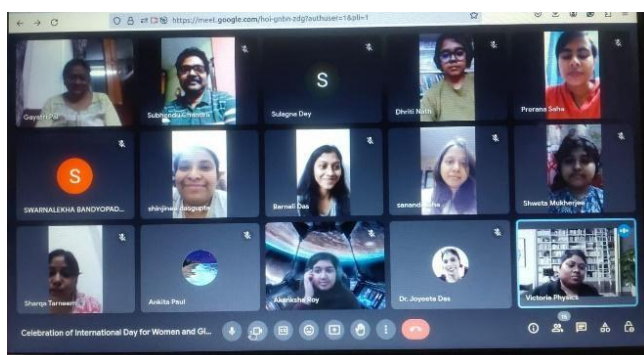

In the year 2015 the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) started the annual observance on 11th February to encourage and promote more participation of women in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) fields, thus breaking the gender stereotypes.

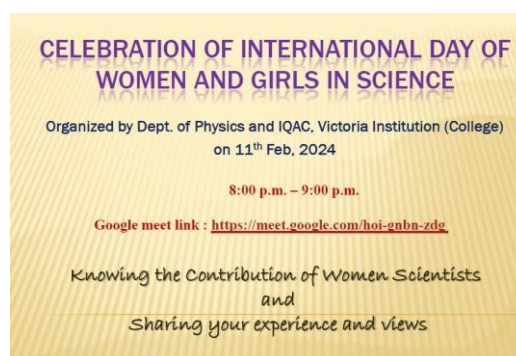
Nine students from the Physics department of semesters I, III and V participated in the program. Principal Madam and the faculties the Department of Physics, Political Science & English attended the online celebration.
