

INDUCTION PROGRAMME 2022 for SEMESTER-I Students, 20.09.2022

The Counseling Cell of Victoria Institution (College) organised an induction programme for the students of Semester-I on 20th September, 2022 at the Keshub Memorial Hall from 10 am onwards.

All the members of the counseling cell were present in the program along with the faculty members (advisors of the cell) from the Psychology department and some non-teaching staff who are also the members of the cell. The program was started with a welcome address given by Dr. Paramita Roy Biswas from Dept of Economics followed by a lucid and interesting presentation by the convenor of the cell, Dr. Debjani Das Ghosh from Dept of Zoology. The presentation highlighted different activities carried out by the college throughout the year beside the regular academic pursuits. The objective is to offer the students a holistic learning environment.
