The workshop started at 11 AM. The two eminent speakers in the workshop were Sri. Debasish Biswas, Inspector of Colleges, University of Calcutta and Sri Gurupada Saren, Secretary, Council for Undergraduate Studies, University of Calcutta. The Principal of VIC, Dr. Maitreyi Ray Kanjilal and the IQAC coordinator Dr. Sumallya Karmakar were present in the workshop with their wholehearted support and cooperation. One day workshop was successfully completed on **'PLANT SYSTEMATICS** topic the BIODIVERSITY '. The speaker delivered lecture on the Biodiversity and Conservation as well as demonstrate practical skills on the plant systematic using BENGAL PLANTS, Volume I and II with collected flowering angiospermic plant specimens viz., Leonurus sibiricus (Labiatae), Coccinia grandis (Cucurbitaceae), Oldenlandia corymbosa (Rubiaceae), Leucas aspera (Labiatae), Physalis angulata (Solanaceae), Sida acuta (Malvaceae), Urena lobata (Malvaceae), Urena (Malvaceae) etc. at Botany Laboratory. Broad discussion made with students on nomenclature of taxon, type specimens, role and principals of ICN, artificial keys and their uses, classifications like the artificial system of Linnaeus, the Natural system of Bentham and Hooker and the Phylogenetic system of documentation. Hutchinson. groups, enumeration of plant species of certain geographical regions.


One-day Seminar on "Machine Learning an Explanatory Tool", organized by the Department of Physics and IQAC on 10.10.2023

A seminar titled "Machine Learning an Explanatory Tool" was organized on October 10, 2023 by the Department of Physics and IQAC in the "Suniti Sabhaghar". The resource person was Prof. Amlan Chakraborti, Professor and Director, A.K. Choudhury School of Information Technology, Former Dean, Faculty of Engineering and Technology, University of Calcutta and Visiting professor at IIIT Delhi.

Thirty eight students of 1st, 3rd and 5th semester from various science departments of our college along with faculty members from the Department of Physics and Mathematics and one faculty member of Physics of a neighbouring college participated in the event. Principal Madam and IQAC coordinator graced the occasion. Prof. Chakraborti explained the basic differences between programming algorithm and machine learning and why Machine Learning and Data Analytics have become so important. He also gave an idea about the importance of feature space in Machine Learning, mechanism of Deep Learning which is a multilayered neural network and a subset of Machine Learning. A pertinent issue, that is the importance of ethics in the research and application of Artificial Intelligence was also being discussed by him.

It was an excellent talk and all the participants were enriched by the presentation. We hope that some of the students will consider this multidisciplinary area of science as their future career.


Interactive Session:


