
1. Students' Seminar: 03.07.2019


16. Extension Lecture on Genetic Engineering, Zoology Dept, 26/9/2019

The faculty members cleared their doubts about the functioning of the whole system.




22. Students' Seminar: 03.12.2019

10. <u>Department of Botany</u> <u>Online mode</u>






3. Report on Teacher's Day Celebration on 05.09.2019 By the Department of Physics


