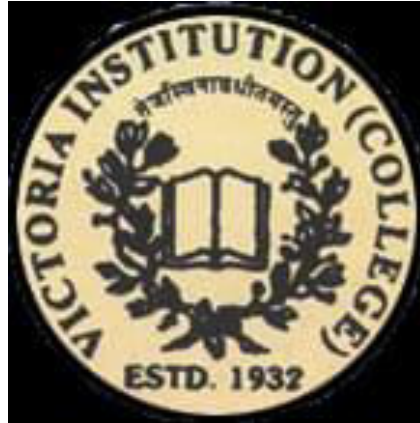

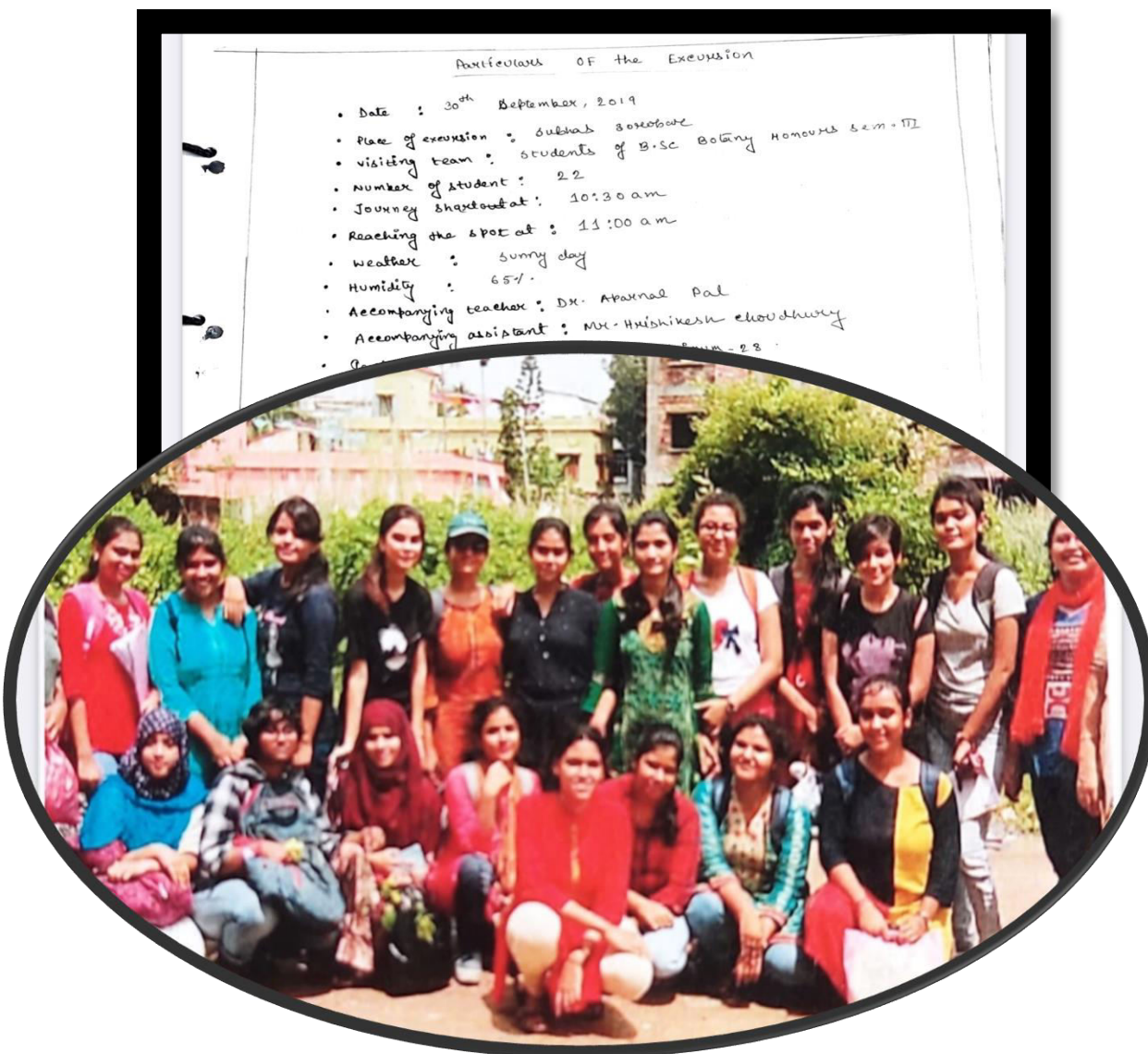

1. Students' Seminar : 03.07.2019

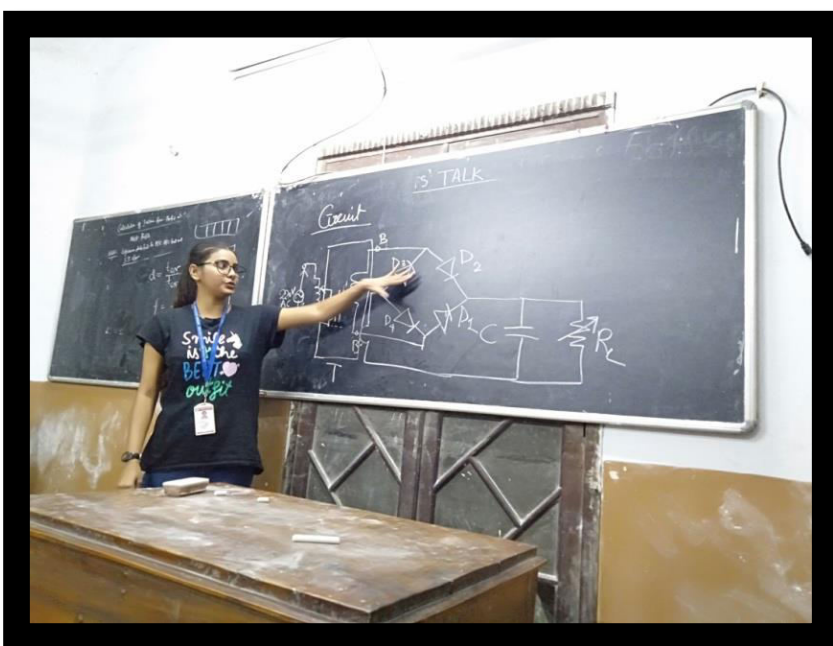
DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS

The meeting came to an end with vote of thanks to the guardian for coming and spending their valuable time with teachers.

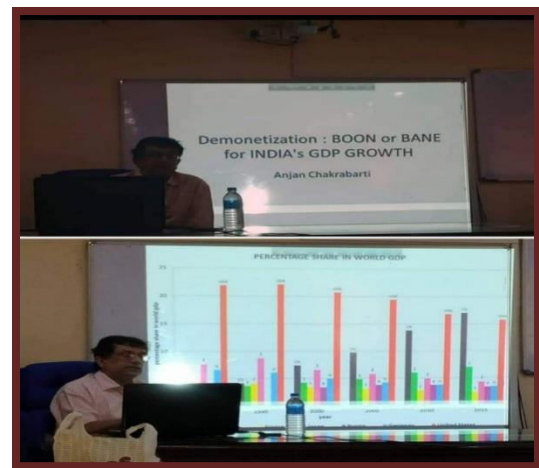
9. Parent Teacher Meet 20/9/2019

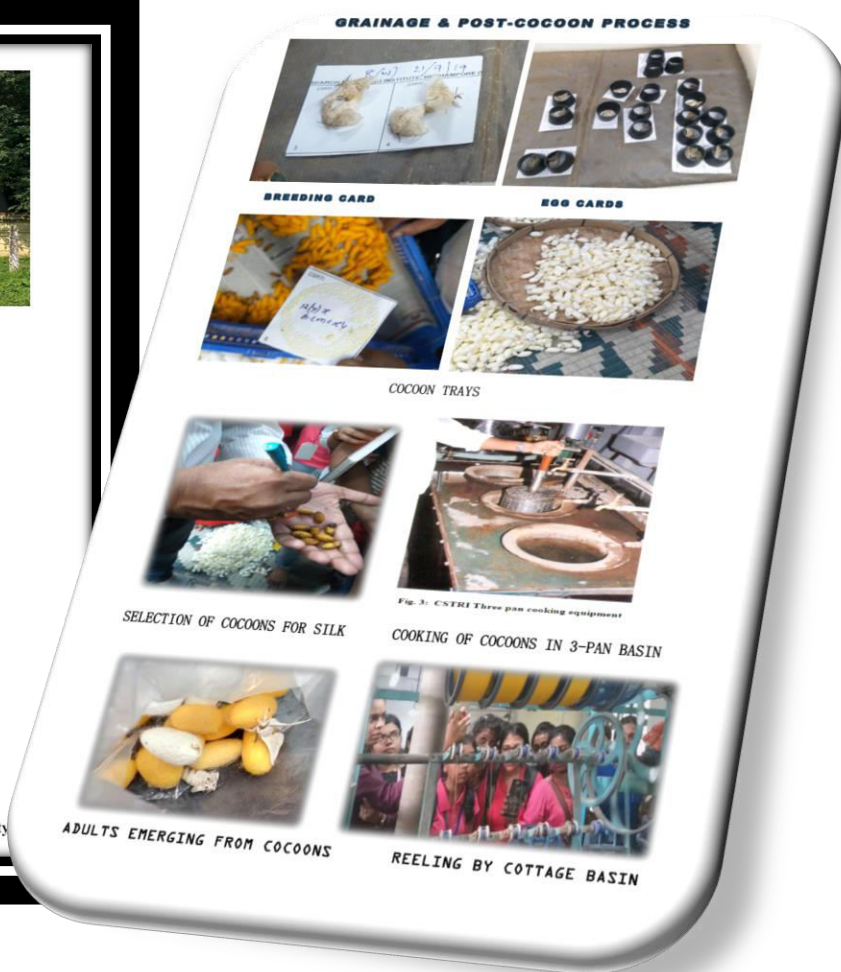
11. Parents Teacher Meeting of the Economics Department on 20/9/2019

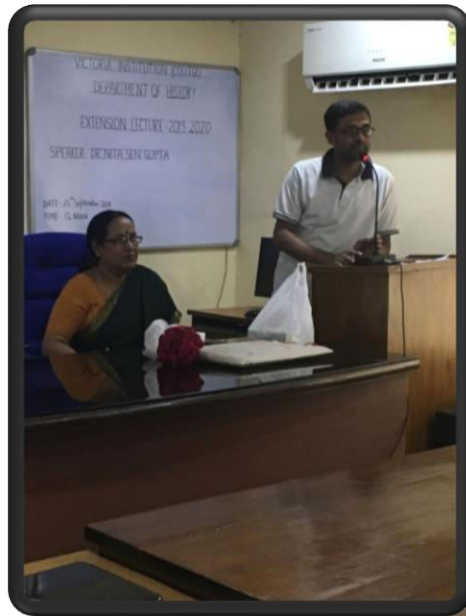
13. Visit to Indian Museum: 24th September 2019, Dept of History

The session was chaired by Principal Madam Dr. Nibedita Chakrabarti, who delivered the welcome address and spoke over the necessity of the lecture.

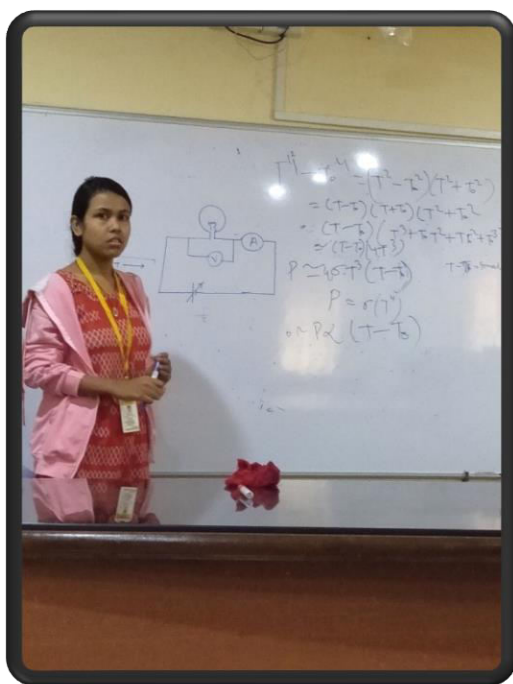
The first part of the session benefitted the faculty members as they were made aware about the newly introduced CBCS system. The faculty members cleared their doubts about the functioning of the whole system.

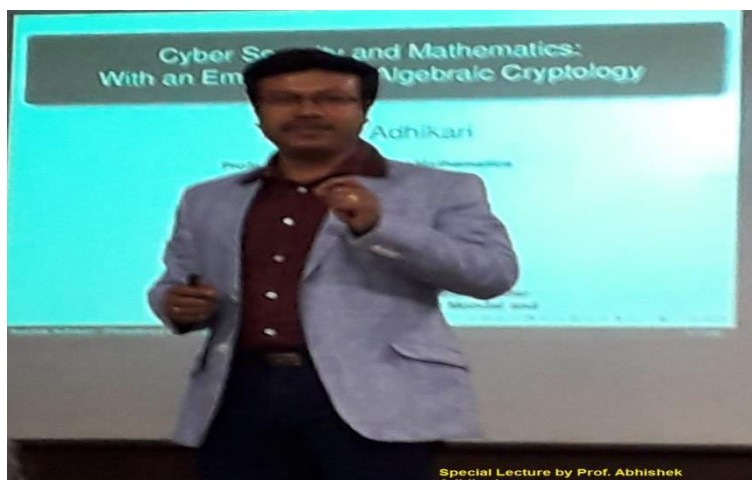


24. Seminar on Cyber Security and Mathematics

28. College Quiz on 26.02.2020

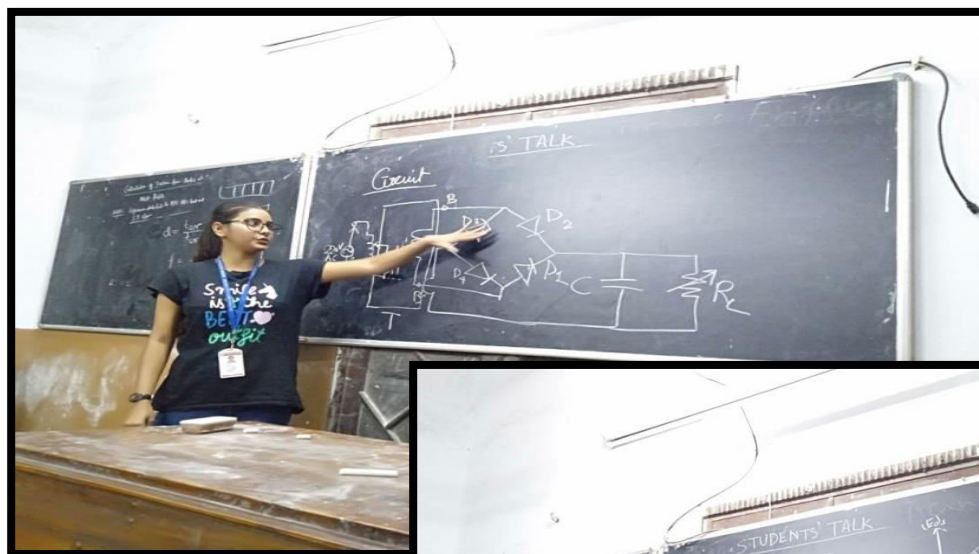
Department of Mathematics
